As a part of the Athens County Committee, the Chamber worked alongside The Athens County Convention and Visitors Bureau, the City of Athens, and Ohio University to host The Wall That Heals in Athens from July 29th - August 1st. The exhibit includes a three-quarter scale replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial along with a mobile Education Center and gives those who cannot travel to Washington D.C. a chance to honor the more than three million Americans who served in the U.S. Armed Forces in the Vietnam War. The planning committee hopes that the exhibit draws visitors to Athens while providing a meaningful experience for the entire community.



Celebration of State Budget Support

On July 29th, legislators, leaders, and community members celebrated the major news that the 2022-2024 Ohio State budget includes \$2 million in funding for the Baileys Trail System (BTS) and the Outdoor Recreation Council of Appalachia (ORCA). It is expected that over the next decade the trail system will bring in \$40 million in increased spending across the region and help to sustainably diversify the SE Ohio economy. Due to the BTS's potential to attract visitors and increase spending in the area, the Athens Area Chamber of Commerce is a part of the ORCA advisory board - a diverse council that provides strategic planning and operational support - and the Chamber uses that position to advocate for the interests of local businesses.
