

### KEEP THE CHEER HERE

This winter it's more important than ever to Keep the Cheer Here in Athens by supporting the local businesses who support the area where you live, work, and play. Shop with our local service providers and businesses to find unique gifts found only in Athens for your family and friends and feel good knowing that for every dollar spent at a local business, over half of that amount stays in Athens and goes back to enrich the community.

According to the Small Business Economic Impact Study, a county-level economic analysis on shopping small commissioned in 2018 by American Express, \$0.67 of every dollar spent at a local business stays in the local community. But what does that mean exactly? If \$100 is spent at a local business, out of the \$67 that stay in Athens, \$44 goes to the small business owner and their



employees' wages and benefits, and \$23 gets spent at other local businesses – in fact, the same study estimated that for every 10 jobs at a small business, another seven are supported in the local community.

The ripple effect from every dollar spent locally can also be seen in the many ways that our local businesses directly support the Athens community. Our local businesses are the ones who sponsor our community sports teams, who donate resources and prizes to non-profits for fundraisers, who spend time and money planning and putting on free Uptown for the Holidays events for everyone in the community to enjoy.

And many of our local businesses go even further in their support of our area. In June 2021, Mathews Insurance helped to address local food insecurity by securing a grant to donate \$5,000 to the Hocking, Athens, Perry Community Action Agency (HAPCAP) to help the Southeast Ohio Foodbank. According to Kelly Hatas, Executive Director of HAPCAP, that grant had a big impact on our community: "We are so grateful for the generous support... [it] will have a direct impact on fighting food insecurity and will help us provide the support and hope needed to be successful." And in September 2021, Third Sun Solar announced that they will be partnering with the Village of Chauncey and the Baileys Trail System to provide clean energy at the Chauncey-Dover Community Park trailhead, which will reduce the Village's utility costs for the next two decades or more.

So this holiday season, as you hunt for unique gifts, plan your holiday party, or design the perfect charcuterie board for your guests, Keep the Cheer Here and spend your dollars locally. You'll end up with one-of-a-kind gifts and experiences found only in Athens, and you'll be supporting our community at the same time.
